Lions Club Nootdorp Nootdorp-Pijnacker organized a great night with an amazing result.

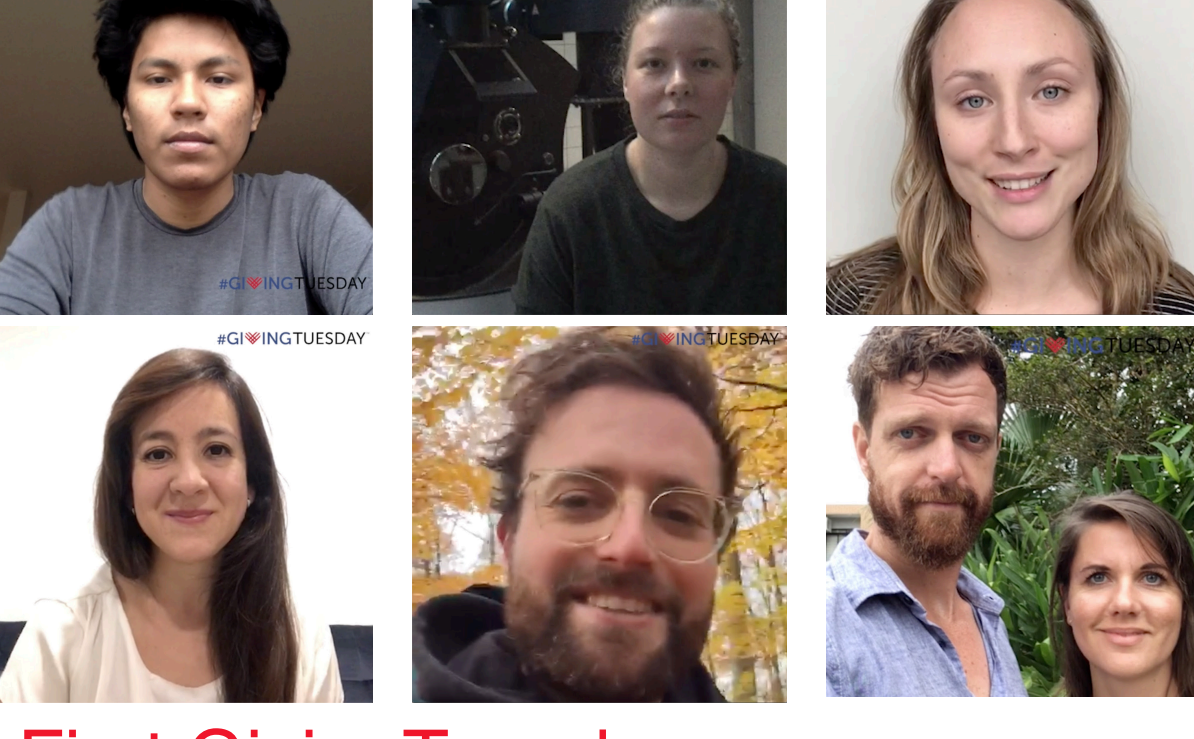
